Competed in the British Championships in March, National Finalist in 200m Backstroke, Semi Finalist in 100m Backstroke, NQT in 400IM and 800m Free.

Aman also was presented with a Berks South Bucks County Record certificate for the LC 200m backstroke in a time of 2:09.14 achieved in the final at the National Youth Championships. A record he claimed from Simon Burnett no less!
